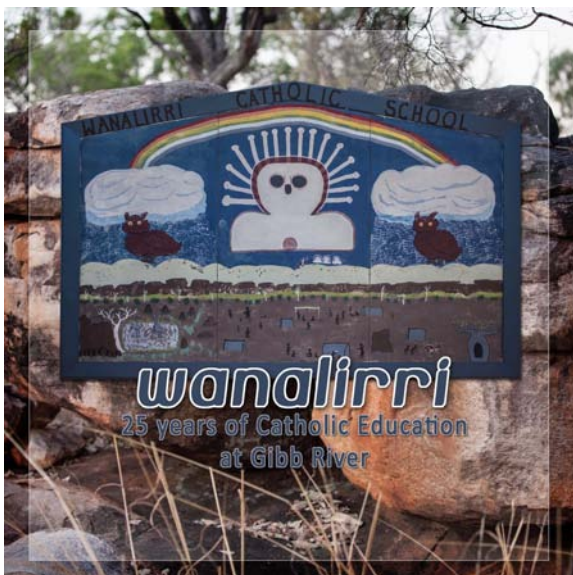
School Mass Tuesday 9.00am
