Wanalirri School Newsletter Week 5 Term 2 2018

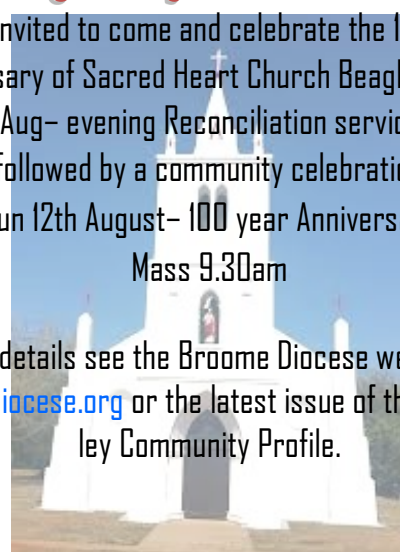
